On June 25th a slew of bills were introduced in the House which affect the Agency:

1. H. R. 8193 (Addabbo) "A bill to amend the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 to require that the President's report to the Congress with respect to the use of funds by CIA for a non-intelligence gathering operation be in writing."

2. H. R. 8198 (Biester) Creates Joint Committee on Intelligence Operations. This bill is identical to the Baker/Weicker bill.

3. H. R. 8199 (Broomfield and Morgan) Creates a Joint Committee on Intelligence Oversight. Representative Broomfield made a floor statement regarding the bill (attached).

4. H. R. 8203 (Edgar and about 10 others, including Leo Ryan) Designates Majority and Minority Leaders of each house of Congress as members of the National Security Council.

5. H. R. 8227, S. 2008 (Don Edwards; Tunney) A brand new criminal justice bill which Tunney says is a compromise between the Justice Department and Ervin bills and which he says is really super.

We will call for the bills and should have them early next week as they are printed.
